Prayer Requests

- Pray for the women who were baptized last month. It is not unusual for them to face extra challenges afterwards to try to discourage them. Pray they will continue to grow in their faith and in understanding of who they are in Christ.
- Pray for "M-t" one of the youngest who was baptized. She has come under some oppression and has struggled to come into work regularly. We are concerned that a Thai boyfriend may be holding her back.
- Pray for Tukata and Den in their marriage.
- We have several women who are pregnant. Please pray for the health of the babies and the mothers.
- We are struggling once again with the unreasonable demands of the landlady of one of our buildings. We need the space but grow weary of her exploitation. Pray for wisdom and breakthrough.
- Pray for wisdom and strategy in growing the business to allow for more women to be hired. Our present company registration limits us to 80 employees.
- Pray for our staff and volunteer staff who face so many battles and work overtime to provide work, to build, to improve, to create, to minister, to reach out and to make a difference. They are often overwhelmed with the challenges and demands on them. Many of them work for free and give their lives and hearts to serve NightLight. Pray for their protection and for their strength to persevere and be renewed daily.
- Pray for me, Annie, as I travel to the US for a couple weeks of speaking in the LA area. My knee has improved greatly but I am not looking forward to a long airplane ride.
- Please pray for our NL USA staff and volunteers that

they would be protected and renewed daily as well.

- Pray for a continual release of resources for purchasing the jewelry and bags. In spite of the economic difficulties, please pray that those who do have the means will continue to buy and invest in the transformation of lives. We need to keep the women busy creating jewelry and pay their salaries. Many around the world are getting layed off and I find that tragic. We do not want to come to that point. If our women lost their job it would send them back into prostitution. We believe God will provide but we know we have to pray continually for the resources to be released.

Thank you so much for your encouragment. We know there is so much more of both blessings and challenges ahead and we rely so much on your support and prayers. Thank you for being faithful when life is hard around the world for so many. Your prayers are valuable and life-changing.
